Wonder

- Ask a question! Ask many questions!
- Rank the questions.
- Choose a topic.
- Make a prediction. Develop a hypothesis.

Investigate

- Gather resources and organize sources.
- Use many varied sources.
- Take lots of notes!
- Start a bibliography.

Express

- Communicate your findings!
- What is the big idea you want to express?
- Make connections.
- Think of audience.

Evaluate

- Draw conclusions!
- Use primary and secondary sources as evidence.
- Validate and back-up your conclusions.

Create

- Review the research.
- Interpret and analyse.
- Create new understanding.
- Think about the original question.
